

# DISTRICT 3800 INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S PARTY

The idea that was recommended by Past RI President MAT Caparas, endorsed by RI President Kalyan Banerjee and implemented by District 3800 and all the Districts in the country was held last July 1, 2011 and onwards. Almost all the clubs in the 9 (nine) Zones in the District heeded the call of Majestic Governor Raffy Garcia to share the first day of their term with children of their favorite school or community. A fitting activity to usher in a Rotary year that will according to RI President Kalyan Banerjee, emphasize on the Family, Continuity and Change.

There were 26 clubs that participated in the simultaneous holding of the District Children's Party with three zones namely: Zone 2 -Unified Caloocan (8 clubs), Zone 6 -Pasig (11 clubs), and Zone 8 -Mandaluyong (7 clubs) holding joint projects, making for an aggregate number of 52 clubs participating in various activities, ranging from the most popular Jolibee meal, clowns, magicians, games, book giving and gift giving all for the purpose of spending time with the children and their parents in the community. The project although simple, was indeed a perfect way to make the communities that we serve aware of what Rotary really stands for.

The following reports are the actual account of the activities that were submitted to SDG Luz Cotoco and the GML during the lauching of the first ever simultaneous Children's Party in the District and the Philippines.

Another idea that Past RI President MAT Caparas recommended to District Governor Raffy Garcia III was the creation of a Happy New Rotary Year card which the Rotary Club of Marikina East thru Gerard Santos made for RI President Kalyan Banerjee, Past RI President MAT Caparas and District Governor Raffy Garcia III. 








# **RC MARIKINA HILLTOP**
