Secretary General's Reminders

We hope that the newly inducted members of all clubs are already reported to RI because they should appear in the next semester's SAR that will be available at the start of next year. The district office would like to reiterate the appropriate reporting so that we can properly account for all clubs' membership increases and we hope that you will achieve your membership goals or at least obtain a net increase of 5% membership growth.

Our district was one of those who quickly responded to the relief campaign for the Typhoon Pablo victims in Mindanao. Thru our District Committee on Disaster Preparedness, we were able to send relief goods to the affected areas. Gov. Lirio coordinated well to the designated person of the district governor covering the area, who is the Assistant Governor and Past President of RC Tagum North. All Rotarians are still requested to continue the campaign especially for food to sustain the needs in the evacuation centers. We made an arrangement with DSWD that all relief goods that will be flown by the Philippine Army's C 130 plane will be endorsed to the Rotarians in Mindanao who help in distributing relief goods to the typhoon victims.

As we all know, the process of mid-year review for all clubs is different from the tradition. As part of the innovations applied by Gov Lirio, all Assistant Governors will do the club level reviews thru club visits or club assemblies starting next month, with the supervision of the Lt Governors. The review will focus on the Presidential Citation requirements and the implementation of the action plans from the annual goals of the club strategies.

At the start of the New Year, we will become busy preparing for the District Conference. Hopefully, many Rotarians would have availed the early bird discounts, as attractively offered by the DISCON 2013 Committee. Talent night practices are expected to be organized by zones. All Peace Builder Presidents and their spouses will join the practices of the Governor's ball that is organized by the Spouses Committee and will start on January 6, 2013, and every Sunday thereafter. The practices will be held at the Rizal High School Gymnasium, Pasig City.

We need your cooperation in preparing for your club's updated rosters, list of officers and activity pictures that you would like to be printed in our DISCON souvenir program. To avoid rush, we suggest that Peace Builder Presidents should submit these documents earlier to our district office or thru the DISCON 2013 Committee.

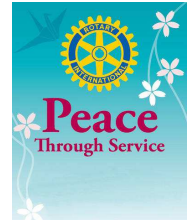

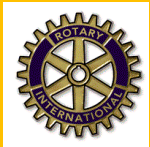
"Service Above Self" is his way of life" ;

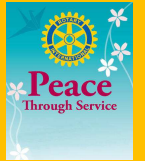

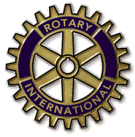

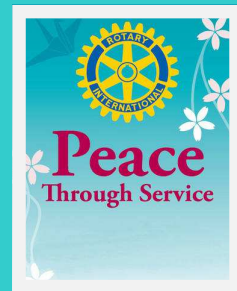
