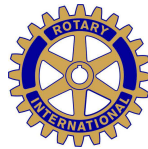
“Identifying Membership Issues, Best Solutions and Strategies to Overcome Them”

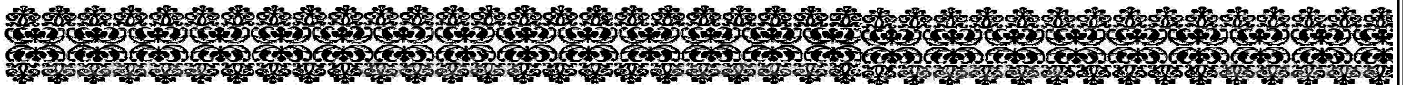
